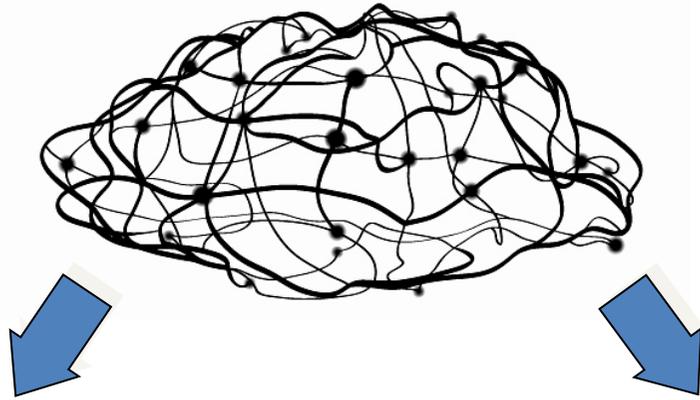

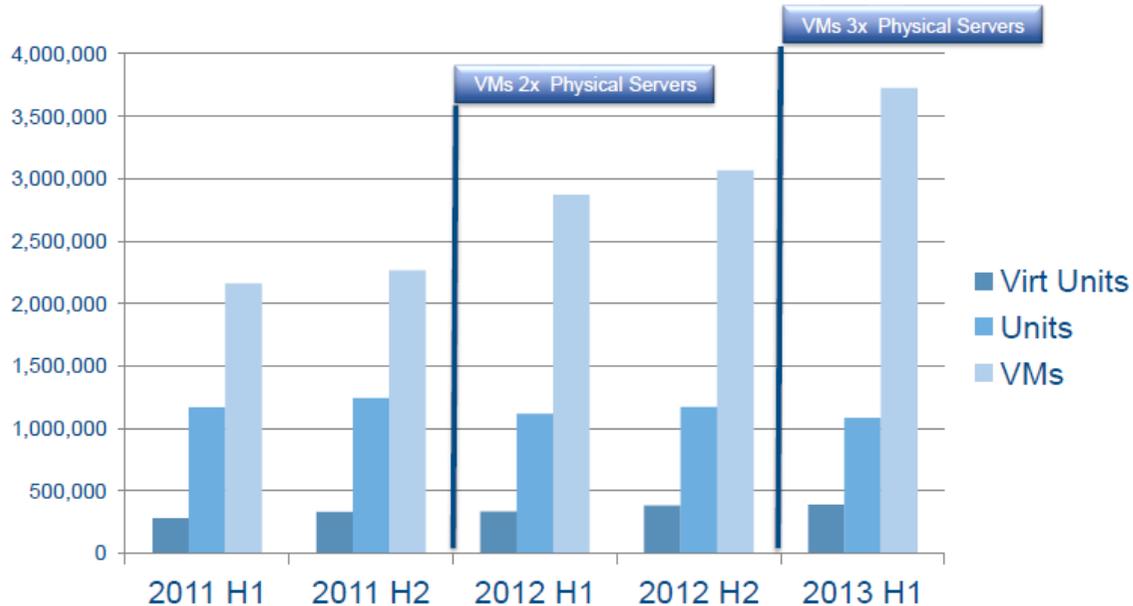

- Critical apps: 12Gb vRAM

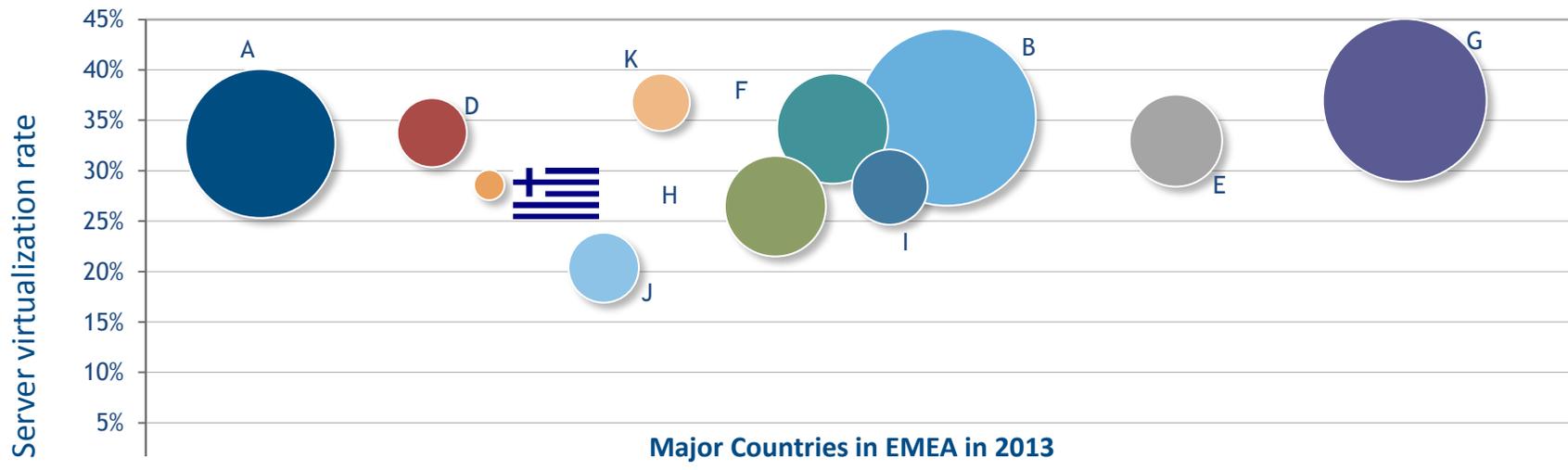
Cloud SP Organization:

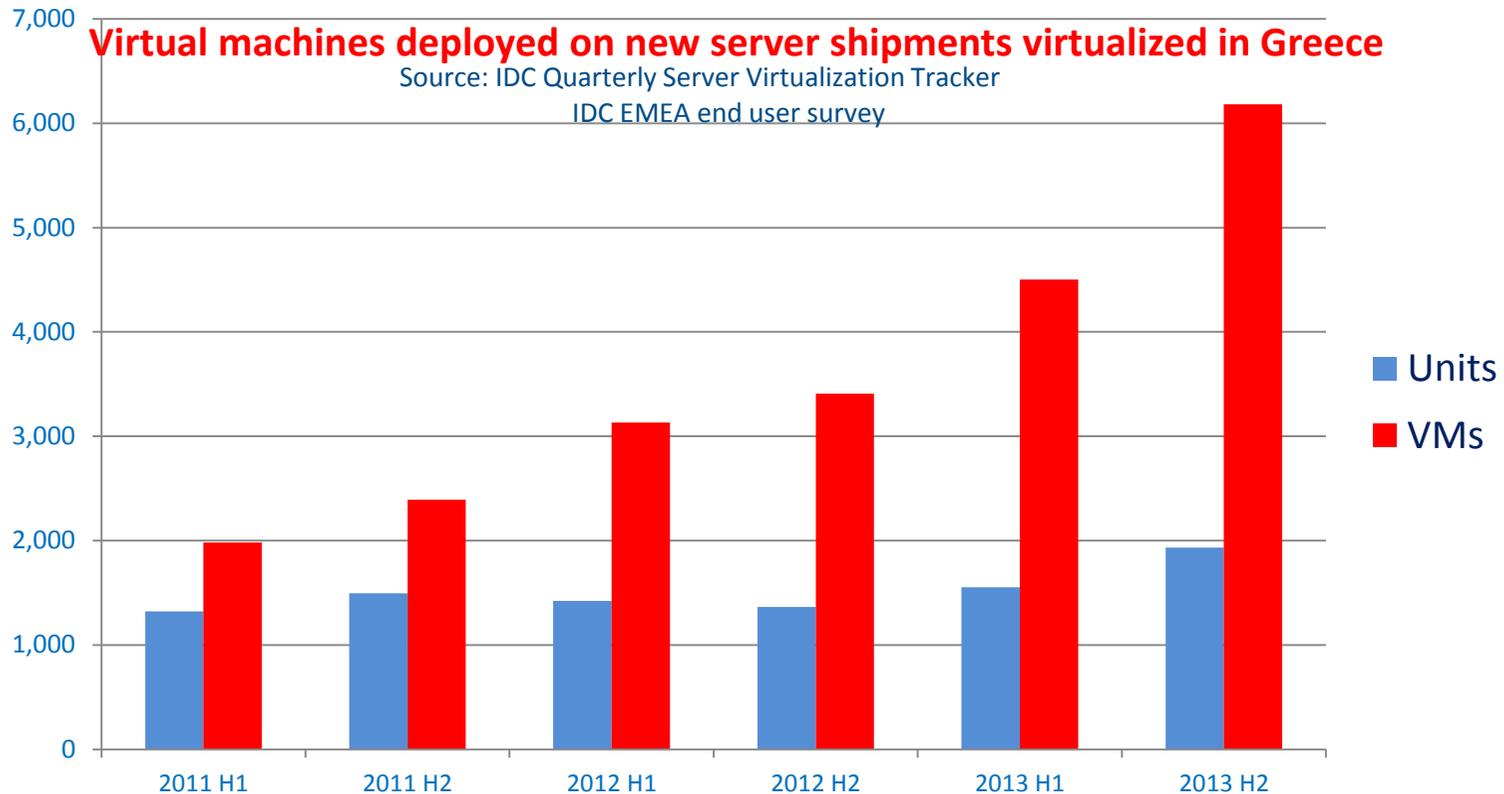

Greek Virtualization rate still at 30%/year more or less in line with the other South Europe and Mediterranean Countries (Italy, Spain, Israel)

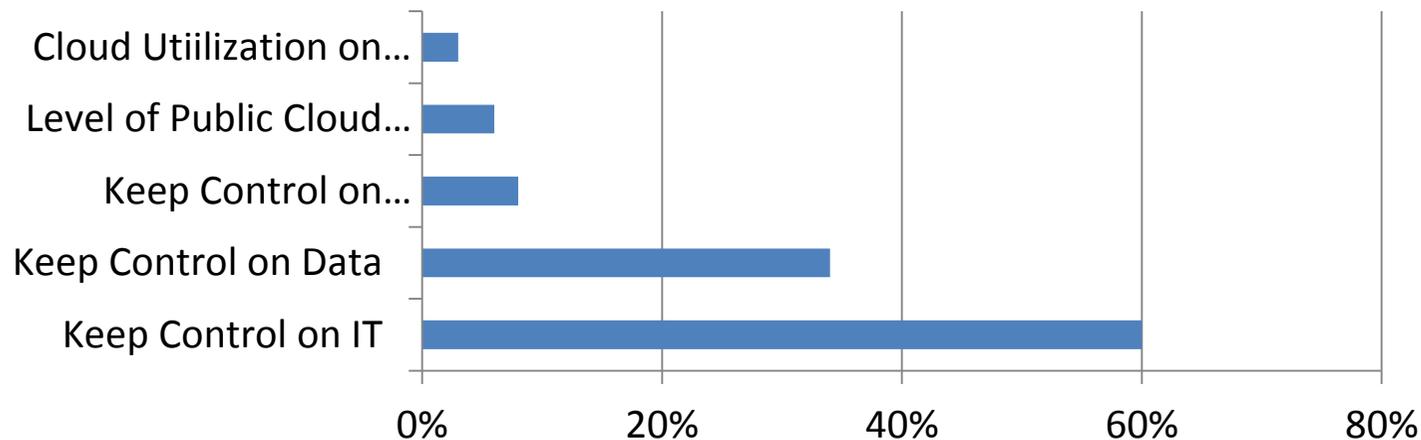

Cloud Business in Greece



- ▶ IT virtualization for Enterprise Customers are increasingly adopted by large organizations
- ▶ +22,000 Cloud VMs in operations since 2011, with a 2013 run rate of +10,000 new VMs/year (Mainly for enterprise private cloud purposes)
- ▶ Market Intelligence and IDC in Greece reveals that such solutions are gradually adopted also by small and medium enterprises (up to 40 Headcounts).
- ▶ Medium Term Cloud business Projections:
 - ❖ 36M€ by year 2018
 - ❖ of which only 7.5M€ for public Cloud

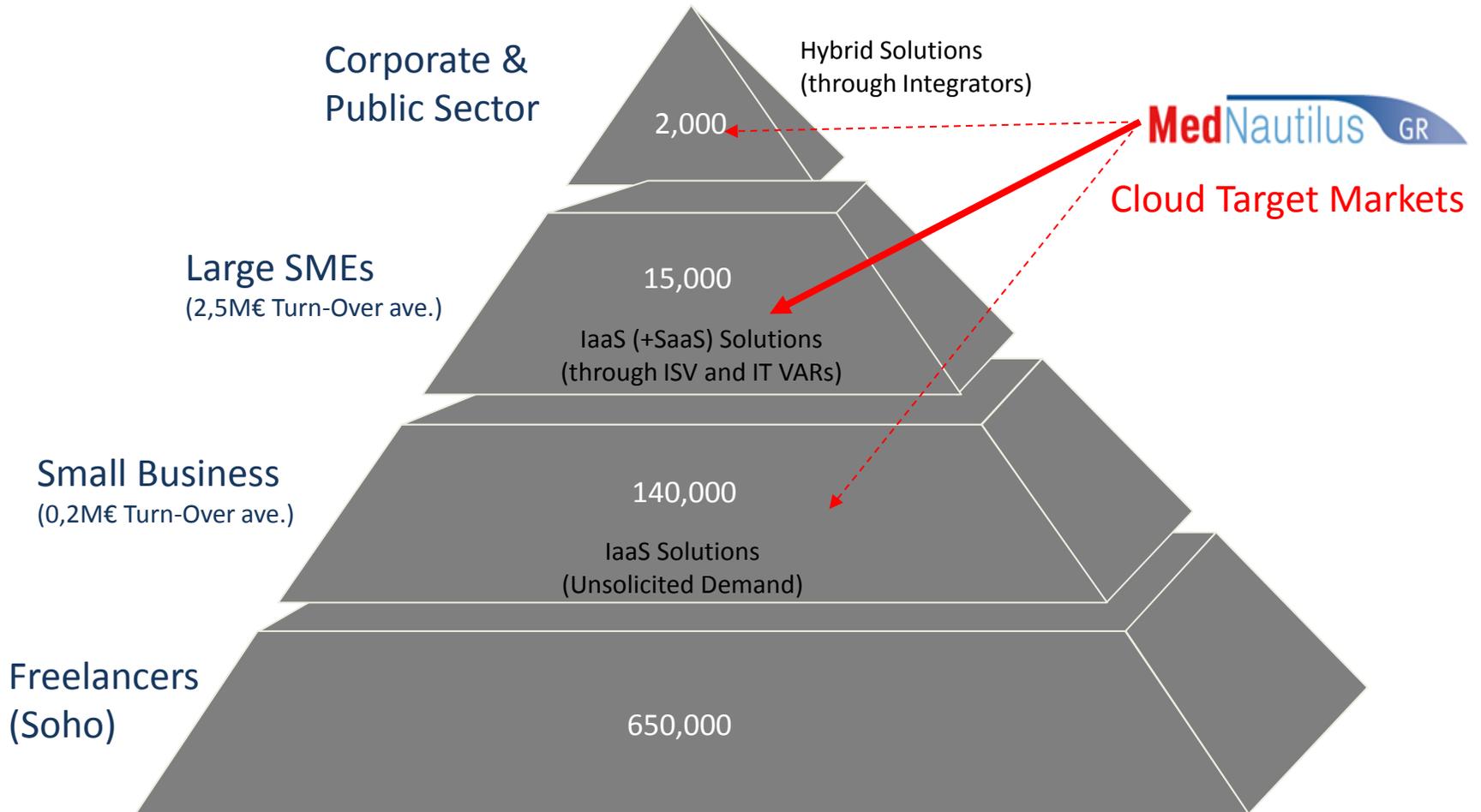
Private vs. Public Cloud Dilemma

lagging behind.**

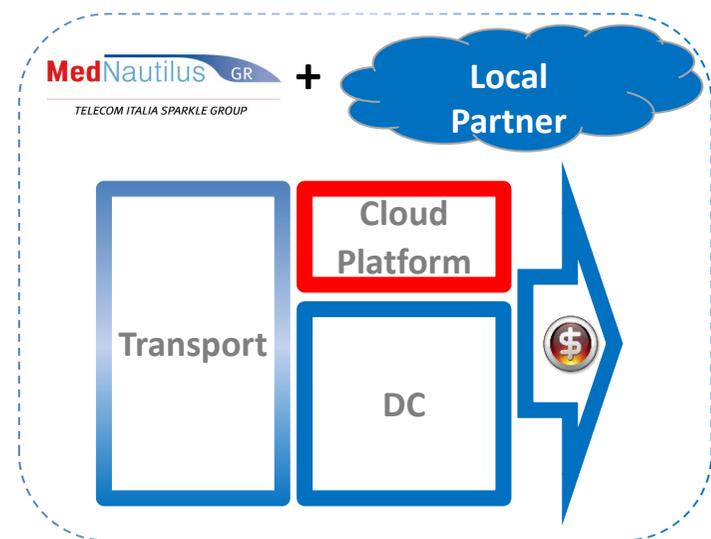
